Year 5 Antarctic Igloo

This week saw the completion of the Year 5 igloo. After weeks of collecting milk containers and strategic planning our Antarctic igloo is finally complete.

The students have enjoyed the experience of building a life-sized igloo and although there were some set backs we were able to overcome these. As with any engineering project there were modifications that needed to be made, and with the help of 76 logical thinkers we were able to come up with another action plan and design.

The students were able to incorporate not only their scientific knowledge to show they were working scientifically and technologically, but also mathematically by calculating the diameter needed, quantities of bottles, sizes and shapes.

This science and technology unit has worked well along side our integrated unit of Antarctica and has made the research we have collected more visual and real.

School Calendar
