## What is Reading Recovery?

Reading Recovery is an early literacy intervention that provides one to one teaching for children who need greater assistance in learning to read and write following their first year of school.

Reading Recovery is a daily, individualised intervention program delivered by a specialist teacher that engages children in reading books and writing their own stories. It also enhances the classroom reading and writing program and enables children to quickly 'catch up' to the average level of their class.

Reading Recovery builds on the strengths of each child and encourages them to become independent, strategic readers and writers.
