## WHOLE SCHOOL WRITING ASSESSMENT TASK

Each term the students from K-6 participate in a whole school writing assessment task. The idea of this is that 'all students will write'! At MIPS, we encourage and find ways for the students to take writing beyond the classroom. The way in which we do this is by providing the students with exciting stimuli based on their interests, experiences or topical issues. The assessed pieces of writing provide staff with consistent and comparative writing data across the school.

The student's writing is not limited to a particular style (Imaginative, Informative or Persuasive)- the focus is on a quality piece of writing. Time is given before the task to discuss what makes a 'good' piece of writing in terms of sentence structure, punctuation, spelling, paragraphs, vocabulary, tense, grammatical content, etc.

The students visit the visual stimulus and are encouraged to plan and write down any ideas in response to the stimuli. Students are then given time to compose a quality piece of writing back in the classroom! At the end of the task, the students proof read and edit their work- this is to not only correct their errors, but also to improve their work by rereading to check meaning (that it makes sense).

This term's visual stimulus titled "Escape to..." has been chosen to compliment this term's Book Week theme 'Escape to Everywhere'. The display has been designed to stimulate the student's imaginations and inspire their creativity when writing. Below is the visual stimulus for this term.


Why not ask your child what they wrote about for this task!!!
