## **Maths Olympiad 2019**

Mary Immaculate have entered an enthusiastic team of children from Year 5 and 6 in the Australasian Problem Solving Mathematical Olympiads (APSMO) Competition. It is estimated that over 60 000 children will compete this year.

Last week the second of five Maths Olympiad competitions for 2019 was held. The Olympiad consist of five separate contests held approximately one month apart between May and September.

The top Mary Immaculate scores for Olympiad 2 were:

**4/5** - Darrell S

3/5 - Joshua C, Noah S, Samuel R, Kanav S, Jacob, G and Isabella N

Congratulations to all of our team for your dedication and hard work and to these children on an exceptional Olympiad result. The next Olympiad will be held on 31st July, 2019.

Here's a sample question for you to try:

#### 5D. Time: 7 minutes

In Sportball, players can score either 4 points or 5 points on any turn. Many scores are possible. For example, teams could score a total of 8 points or 15 points or 13 points.

Some scores are not possible. For example, teams could not score a total of 6 points or 7 points.

What is the highest final score that cannot happen?







## From the Library

#### **Author Visit**


This year we are lucky to have Anna Fienberg visit our school to speak to the students. Anna is the author of the Tashi series plus many more popular children's books.

Beanies, scarves and gloves are now available from the uniform shop. These will be especially welcome for those winter mornings now that the cold weather has well and truly set in!







If you have a child in infants and primary, you will have to register yourself twice.


Once for each code.
