They are recognised for the fabulous learning they are achieving and for the unique young people that they are. Our teachers are just the best. Kindergarten 2020 positions are still available for students to enrol at other catholic schools in the area. St Joseph's, Holy Cross, Good Shepherd and St John's would welcome enrolment applications for 2020.

Congratulations to our whole community for all we are achieving together in making our school the school of choice in Quakers Hill. I know that our reputation will continue to go from strength to strength as we work together for our students. Our thanks for your positivity and energy now and in the future.

NUMERACY NEWS FROM YEAR 5

Students in Year 5 have been learning about two-dimensional shapes and angles. Our learning activities centred around developing the surface knowledge of the properties and features of two-dimensional shapes and the skills required to measure angles using a protractor.

Students were given the opportunity to show a deeper understanding of their surface knowledge by measuring the angles laid out on their desks. They know they've measured a triangle's angles correctly if it all adds up to 180°!

Year 6, who were learning how to calculate the area of a triangle came into the Year 5 learning space to share their knowledge. Year 6 did a fantastic job of explaining their learning while Year 5 was also able to share some of their learning as well.
















MESSAGES FROM P&F

Year 6 Incursion - SCRATCH!

Year 6 had an incursion on Wednesday, 11th September on the use of digital technologies to define problems, design, modify and follow algorithms to develop solutions. The focus was creating flowcharts and algorithms to give instructions to computers to complete a task.

In brief their task was to create an application that:

- Asks a user to input their age
- Works out the year the user was born
- Outputs a complement that is age appropriate

The students were able to come away with new terminology such user input, branching, processing and computer output. They also developed skills that they were able to experiment with using the platform of Scratch.



The year 6 students thoroughly enjoyed the experience and are excited to transfer their new skills into their Science lessons!
