### "BULLY-NO WAY" DAY

Next Friday 16th March is National "Bully-No Way" Day. This is a day when we say "No" to bullying behaviour within our community. During Protective Behaviour lessons this week the children will be learning how to identify bullying behaviour and strategies to help them deal with these situations.



### What is bullying?

Bullying is when someone:

- · keeps picking on you again and again and tries to make you
- · says or does lots of mean things that upset you
- makes fun of you a lot
- tries to stop you from joining in or make others not like you
- · keeps hurting you such as hitting or punching you.

Bullying feels awful. You feel like you can't stop it.

Bullying can happen in person or online. It might be something people can see or it might be hidden.

Sometimes you might have a fight or argument with someone. If it happens once, it is not bullying even though it can be upsetting. It is also not bullying if you sometimes fight with a friend and you can sort it out.

Bullying is not OK. You have the right to feel safe.


### **WEAR GREEN**
