We have seen numerous developments within our learning spaces and we want you to have the opportunity to witness first hand the wonderful quality learning that is taking place for your child.

As previously communicated we are initiating Student-Led Conferences this semester. The conferences are part of a whole school strategy based on current research on maximising student learning acceleration. They also support parent requests to broaden the information provided to them through reporting.

By enabling the students and teachers to regularly keep parents updated on their own child's learning, we are working to ensure parents remain informed through the year and not just at report times. This is being assisted also by the use of Google documents and the Seesaw application. BYOD is also an enabler of parents being able to be more involved in their child's learn.

The children will showcase their achievements, their current challenges and future directions with you. This will provide you with an extensive understanding of your child's areas of strength and next steps in learning.

The students have been working very hard at developing a snapshot of their learning journey over this semester. We urge you to attend your preferred conference time and be part of this very special initiative to witness and support your child's learning development.

The scheduled times will be available for you to book online through the **Skoolbag app**.

Each session is scheduled to run for 30 - 40 minutes and will following the format:-

5 minutes – Welcome from teachers providing a brief outline of the semester's work and an outline for the evening.

20-25 minutes – Your child will take you to their allocated area and begin to share with you their wonderful work samples.

5-10 minutes – You will be asked to assist your child in discussing future learning goals for the upcoming semester.

Your child will be bringing home an invitation containing further details. We hope to see you all there to share a very special time in your child's schooling.
