Literacy Links

Whole School Writing Assessment Task-Term 4

Each term the students from K-6 participate in a whole school writing assessment task. The idea of this is that 'all students will write'! At MIPS, we encourage and find ways for the students to take writing beyond the classroom. The way in which we do this is by providing the students with exciting stimuli based on their interests, experiences or topical issues. The assessed pieces of writing provide staff with consistent and comparative writing data across the school.

The student's writing is not limited to a particular style (Imaginative, Informative or Persuasive)- the focus is on a quality piece of writing. Time is given before the task to discuss what makes a 'good' piece of writing in terms of sentence structure, punctuation, spelling, paragraphs, vocabulary, tense, grammatical content, etc.

The students view the visual stimulus, they're encouraged to plan and write down any ideas in response to the stimuli and then given time to compose a quality piece of writing. At the end of the task, the students proof read and edit their work- this is to not only correct their errors, but also to improve their work by rereading to check meaning (that it makes sense).

This term's visual stimulus was an award winning animated 3D video clip titled 'Soar'. The students only watched a small part of the video clip and were then expected to compose a new ending to the story. Examples of the student's pieces of writing from both this term and last, can be viewed in the Library on the Great Wall of Writing. Please feel free to visit the Library and read them- they are fantastic!! Below is a screen shot of the visual stimulus for this term.

The AFL Future Stars program is an advanced skills testing, training and game development program open to boys and girls aged 11 and 12 Years who **who are not currently playing junior club AFL**, but want to test their athletic ability, agility, speed and endurance.


Our school will appear in 'Nearby Locations' if you're within 10kms of the school, or search for our school by name.






