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Dear Parents and Caregivers,

We are constantly looking to provide our children with the best learning environments possible and as a result, we are preparing for a minor refurbishment at Mary Immaculate. During the upcoming holidays work will be completed in preparation for the re-location of Year 3, the Library and Learning Support. The following moves will take place in the next 6 weeks.

- Year 3 will move from their current space and re-locate in the library space down stairs
- The Library will be moved to the current Learning Support and Art space
- Learning Support and Art will move to the current Year 3 space

The key benefit of these moves is that the Year 3 students will have a space that is larger and fitted with flexible walls that allow the grade to work either in three individual groups or one larger group. The bigger space will also allow for the larger numbers of the grades coming through in subsequent years. The advantage of the library moving to a more central position of the school is also beneficial is it will maintain its profile as an important element of student learning.

We look forward to settling these areas of the school quickly to allow the students and staff to familiarise themselves with their new learning spaces.



## Social Skills Focus at MIPS

This fortnight's Social Skill is:

## JOINING IN

- Decide if you want to join in.
- How will you approach the situation? What will you say?
- Choose a good time
- Say "May I play" in a friendly way.
- How do you make someone feel comfortable to join in?
- Are you approachable and inclusive?
- Take time to stop and notice if there are others that may need encouragement or a friend to help them join in.

<u>Parent Links</u>: Encourage your child to have friends over to play. Remind the children of the importance of fair play and following the rules of the game. Let them know at the end of play how well they went. "You and John must be feeling good about the way you took turns, played by the rules and didn't leave anyone out when you were playing today". If there are problems, ask the children to think of ways both could get what they want without being left out of the game. Help your child to resolve conflict that may occur in a positive way "How can we make things better?" Remind your child about the importance of being inclusive and not leaving anyone out.


