#### Dear Parents/Carers

The students at Mary Immaculate are just wonderful. The teachers do a tremendous job working with them to achieve outstanding learning and behavioural outcomes. To keep this all going well and to, perhaps, even enhance it further we will be introducing a whole school approach to sustaining and developing our learning culture, we are looking to introduce PBS4L.

What is PBS4L?

Positive Behaviour Support for Learning (PBS4L) brings together the whole-school community to contribute to developing a positive, safe and supportive learning culture. The framework assists schools to improve social, emotional, behavioural and academic outcomes for children and young people.

When PBS4L is implemented well, teachers and students have more time to focus on relationships and classroom instruction. Students and staff benefit from:

- reduced problem behaviour
- increased time focused on instruction
- improved social-emotional wellbeing
- positive and respectful relationships among students and staff
- support for teachers to teach, model and respond effectively to student need
- a predictable learning environment where staff and students know what is expected to deliver effective practices that can be sustained over time.

PBS4L can be implemented in any school setting to support students from pre-school through to Year 12. The framework supports schools to identify and successfully implement evidenced-based whole-school practices that enhance learning outcomes for children and young people. This is achieved by using the framework to strengthen systems within the school such as, structures, and processes that underpin ongoing school improvement and the effectiveness of all school members. The process involves a school leadership team implementing four critical and connected features across each tier of the PBL continuum:

- 1. Outcomes are locally determined, contextually and culturally relevant and measurable. These include academic, social-emotional and behavioural achievements for all students.
- 2. Systems are staff focused. They include policies and procedures that support all staff to enable the accurate and durable implementation of the practices that support students.
- 3. Data the information that is used to identify the current status, the need for change and the effects of interventions. Data on student behaviour, academic performance, attendance and other key indicators is considered by the team. Data on how well the practices are being implemented is essential. By reviewing data frequently school teams can make decisions to select, differentiate or discontinue practices based on need.
- 4. **Practices** are student focused. They are the evidence-based interventions and strategies that support students. Practices are selected and adjusted to ensure they are culturally and contextually relevant.

Our PBS4L Framework will also involve our COSHC colleagues so as to provide consistency for our students while at MIPS.


We will be generating our Framework over the remainder of the year in preparation for whole school launch next year.


